Symptoms of Dog Heat Stroke

Symptoms of heat stroke in dog include:

Excessive panting
Salivation
Body temperature of 104° or more
Collapse
Diarrhea
Vomiting
Increased, thumping heart rate
Depression
Stupor or appearing in a daze
Seizures
Coma

Heatstroke is usually seen in the months between November and March.

Treatment of Dog Heat Stroke

There are several steps that need to be immediately taken:

1. Move your dog to a cool place such as an air conditioned room.
2. Take rectal temperature every 10 minutes to see if it is coming down.
3. If rectal temperature is 40C - 43C cool your dog with cool water from something like a garden hose or bucket, a cool water bath, ice packs applied to the abdomen or groin area or place in front of a fan.

Seek veterinary care immediately for canine heat stroke. Heat stroke can be particularly dangerous if you cannot cool your dog's temperature within 20 minutes

4. Wipe paws with cool water (paws are the only area on a dog that can sweat).
5. Once temperature reaches 39C or less than stop cooling to avoid hypothermia.

A reader recently sent a note recommending a [Dog Cooling Jacket](#). These come in different sizes and rely on either water or gel which is cooled prior to putting them on your dog.

Side Effects of Heat Stroke in Dogs

Heat stroke in dogs can result in a breathing problem called laryngeal edema and hyperthermia (high body temperature). Hyperthermia can result in problems such as kidney disease, bleeding, heart arrhythmia and seizures.

These side effects can set in on the same day or within weeks of heat stroke. Be sure to consult with your veterinarian.

In most dogs if they can survive for 72 hours from the onset of the condition, then they should be fine.

Symptoms of Dog Heat Stroke Continued

Prevention of Canine Heat Stroke

As mentioned, dogs cannot cool themselves on hot days since panting becomes less effective the hotter it gets. This is why it is important not to leave your dog in the car in the summer, even with the window cracked open. A good guideline is to cool your dog or give your dog water when you feel the need for yourself.

The key to heatstroke is to recognize it as early as possible and to immediately begin bringing your dog's body temperature down to 39C.

Roundworms

Roundworms are the most common of the parasitic worms found inside a dog. Almost all dogs become infected with them at some time in their lives, usually as puppies. Roundworms may be contracted in different ways, making them easy to spread and hard to control.

Your dog may be infected with roundworms from the time it is born because often the mother passes the worms to the puppy while it is still in her body. Roundworms can also develop in a puppy after it is born when the puppy eats larvated eggs from the environment or drinks worm larvae (young worms) in the mother's milk. Another way roundworms are passed is when roundworm larvae are present in the tissues of a mouse or another small mammal and the puppy eats the animal.

How will roundworms affect my dog?

Adult roundworms live in the affected dog's intestines. Many dogs do not have signs of infection; however, dogs with major roundworm infections, especially puppies, show diarrhea, vomiting, weight loss, dull hair, and a potbellied appearance. The dog may cough if the roundworms move into the lungs.

You may notice the adult roundworms in your dog's feces or vomit. They will appear white or light brown in color and may be several inches long.

How do I prevent my dog from getting roundworms?

Because roundworms can enter your dog's body in many different ways, it is essential to keep your dog's living area clean, remove feces regularly, and, if possible, prevent your dog from eating wild animals that may carry roundworms.

To get rid of roundworms that are passed from the mother dog, puppies should be treated at 2, 4, 6, and 8 weeks of age and then receive a preventive treatment monthly. Fecal (stool) examinations should be conducted 2 to 4 times during the first year of life and 1 or 2 times each year in adults. Nursing mothers should be kept on monthly preventive and treated along with their puppies to decrease the risk of transmission.

Many heartworm preventives also control roundworms. Ask your veterinarian about prevention and treatment choices that are appropriate for your dog.

Can humans be harmed by roundworms?

Roundworms do pose a significant risk to humans. Contact with contaminated soil or dog feces can result in human ingestion and infection. Roundworm eggs may accumulate in significant numbers in the soil where pets deposit feces. Once infected, the worms can cause eye, lung, heart and neurologic signs in people.

Children should not be allowed to play where animals have passed feces. Individuals who have direct contact with soil that may have been contaminated by cat or dog feces should wear gloves or wash their hands immediately.

CLUB GROUND RULES

These rules apply to all handlers and have been formulated for the welfare of you and your dog.

- Any Club member, or any person guilty of unseemly conduct or acts harmful to the club, may be asked to leave the Club grounds. They may also be dealt with by the Committee of The GSDC of SA Inc. under clause 6, and relative by-laws of the Clubs Constitution.
- Members shall not treat their dog in a manner that may reflect badly on the Club.
- The owner and or handler shall be responsible for their dogs while on club grounds and must accept any liability for animals in their care at all times.
- The handlers of dogs that foul the Club Grounds will be responsible for cleaning up same, with the equipment provided.
- Any dog that is sick **WILL NOT** be permitted onto the Club Grounds.
- Dogs who have suffered a **CONTAGIOUS DISEASE WILL NOT** be allowed on to the Grounds until 5 weeks after being cleared by a veterinarian (a vets certificate may be required). Puppies should not be brought out onto the Club Grounds under the age of 8 weeks or at least 2 weeks after they have been inoculated for **HEPATITIS, DISTEMPER AND PARVOVIRUS** (vaccination certificate may be required).
- The Head Instructor has the authority to permit the use of a muzzle or training devices, as required in special cases. The use of the equipment is to be under supervision, and its use on the Grounds, other than above, is **STRICTLY FORBIDDEN**.
- The use of switches, spiked collars or whips is **STRICTLY FORBIDDEN ON THE CLUB GROUNDS**.
- Dogs are **NOT** to be taken off lead or left unattended, except on the directives, or under the supervision of a Class Instructor.
- Bitches in season are not permitted on the grounds unless at a recognised conformation show.
- Dogs under the age of 12 months **ARE NOT** permitted to use jump equipment higher than 400 mm, or longer than 800 mm.
- The handlers of dogs that foul the Club Grounds will be responsible for cleaning up same, with the equipment provided.
- Pursuant of the Health act "Dogs" **ARE NOT** permitted inside the Club Rooms.
- In the interest of safety and health, and in consideration of others, parents are required to supervise the behaviour of their children. The Club Rooms and Toilets **MUST NOT** be used as playing areas.
- In the interests of public health the Club Rooms and the veranda area are **NON-SMOKING** areas.
- Appropriate foot wear must be worn at **ALL** times when handling/double handling dogs on the Club Grounds. Bare feet, thongs, slip on shoes, high heels, sandals, crocs and shoes with metal-spiked soles (covered or uncovered) are not suitable foot wear and members wearing any of the above will be asked to leave the Club grounds.

Training Extreme Weather Policy

Training will be cancelled if the forecast temperature for **West Beach** is predicted to be 37 degrees or above or an Extreme Storm warning is issued on www.eldersweather.com.au at 6pm the night before training (Wednesday nights and Sunday mornings).
