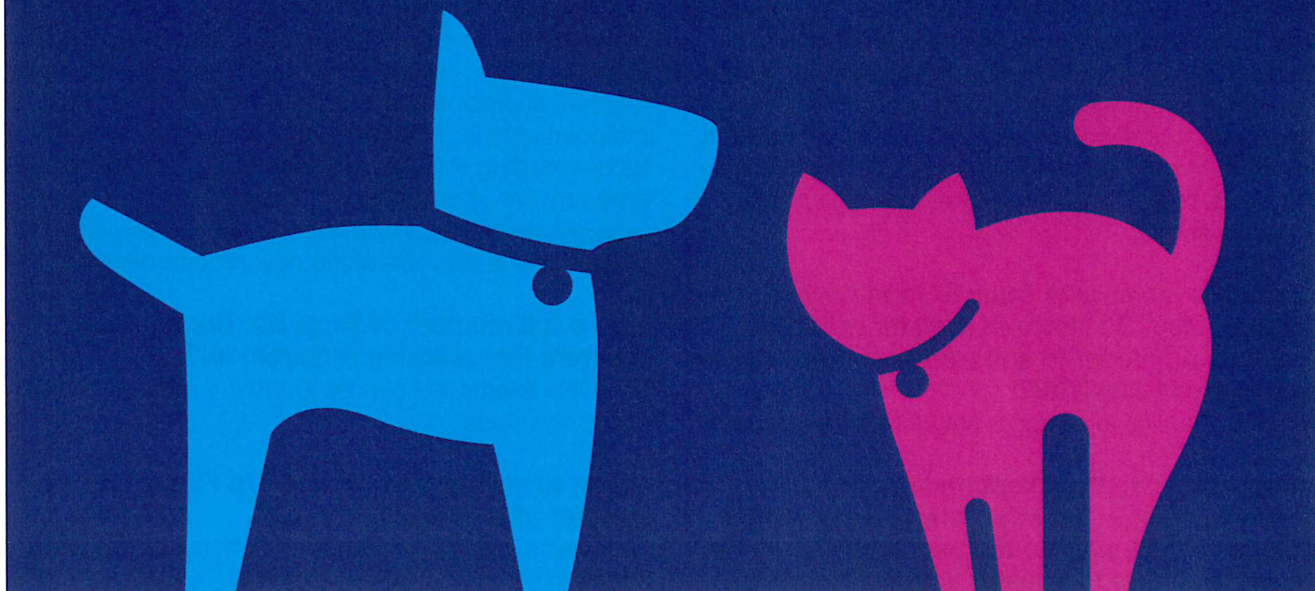

DOG AND CAT REFORMS

WHAT YOU NEED TO KNOW

If you're a member of Dogs SA, there are changes to the law that might effect you. This FAQ tackles the most common question for pedigree owners, including your role in helping shine a light on unscrupulous breeders.

What's the difference between breeder registration, council dog registration and Dogs SA membership/prefix renewal?

- Breeder Registration is a new requirement under the *Dog and Cat Management Act 1995*, to help the government track and manage breeding in the whole SA community, not just pedigree breeders. This will help weed out unscrupulous breeders from the industry.
- Council registration funds important dog management services within your local community, including animal management officers, creation and maintenance of dog parks, education and poo bags in local parks.
- Dogs SA renewal/prefix are the annual membership fees you pay to Dogs SA; an incorporated body that promotes pedigree breeding to high standards, organises official shows and advocates on behalf of members to government.

Is it mandatory for all dogs and cats to be desexed under the new rules?

No. This requirement only applies to dogs and cats born after 1 July 2018. Full members of Dogs SA and breeders registered with the Dog and Cat Management Board are exempt.

Does breeder registration replace council registration?

No. The two are separate. Any dogs you own must be registered with the council where they reside.

Does breeder registration replace Dogs SA renewal or prefix?

No.

Do mandatory microchips replace council registration?

No. Council registration funds vital dog management services in your community. Microchips simply make your dog easier to identify and return home if lost or stolen.

Does the RSPCA enforce breeder registration?

No. The new breeder register will be administered by the Dog and Cat Management Board. The RSPCA deals with animal welfare issues.

Does the RSPCA enforce the new *South Australian Standards and Guidelines for Breeding and Trading Companion Animals (2017)*?

The new Standards and Guidelines for Breeding and Trading Animals are a new animal welfare initiative to help weed unscrupulous operators out of the industry. The RSPCA will have some role in enforcing the new standards and guidelines, as they do with all animal welfare issues.

I am not a member of Dogs SA/don't own a pedigree dog. Do I have to register with the Board as a breeder to sell a litter and keep pups entire after 1 July 2018?

Yes. This applies to all dogs, not just pedigree breeds.

I have access to dogs kept on separate properties under "breeder terms". How do the changes affect me? Do the people who care for these dogs have to register with the Board as breeders?

The *Dog and Cat Management Act 1995* deems the "owner" of a dog to be the person who last registered the dog with a local council – unless there is proof to the contrary. The new obligations to microchip and desex fall on the "owner". So, if the breeder remains the owner, wants to keep the dog entire but has arranged for the dog to be kept with another person, we recommend you record the arrangements you have made, in a written agreement.

What constitutes desexing?

The Act defines desexing as a permanent surgical procedure that renders your dog incapable of reproducing. For female dogs, the Board recommends the removal of the ovaries and the uterus. For male dogs, the Board recommends the removal of both testicles. This is due to the added behaviour benefits associated with this type of desexing. Tubal ligation and vasectomy are also acceptable under the Act.

Will Dogs SA members have full access to the new DACO database?

It is intended that owners will have access to records about their own dogs and cats and the ability to update these records. In addition, limited contact information about breeders registered with the Board will also be publically available, to enable purchasers to contact the breeder of their pet.

How are the new regulations going to address puppy farms?

Puppy farms thrive in a system with no accountability. DCM Board breeder registration, the new standards and guidelines, and point of sale requirements, shine a light on those operators that do not meet the exacting standards set by most pedigree breeders. In time, consumers will come to expect their next dog comes from a breeder registered with the Board who supplies a name, contact details and a registration number at the point of sale. Enforcement of the new rules will focus weeding out unscrupulous operators. Reputable breeders are encouraged to contact their local council regarding advertisements for animals for sale or giveaway that don't meet the new requirements.

I am a full member of Dogs SA. Does this exempt me from the desexing requirement?

Yes. This exemption can be found in regulation 12(2) of the new rules.

I want to use my dog at stud. Do I have to register as a breeder?

Not unless you receive puppies from a litter which you intend to sell. Full Dogs SA members are allowed to keep entire dogs and don't have to register with the Board as a breeder unless they intend to sell a litter.

I'm a full Dogs SA member. Do I get a discount on my DCM Board breeder registration?

Yes. Dogs SA has negotiated a deal which gives full members discounted breeder registration with the Dog and Cat Management Board. Non-members will pay 50% more than full members to register as a breeder.

Which regulations define desexing at the point of sale?

Regulation 18.

How will the new advertising requirements be enforced on sites like Gumtree or community noticeboards?

Gumtree is required to operate under Australian law, and works with governments to ensure compliance on other advertisement categories (i.e. listing the odometer reading on cars, builder's licence numbers, etc.). The Board will work with Gumtree and other providers to ensure that a valid breeder registration number will be a compulsory addition to any advertisement for a dog (or cat) for sale. Consumer pressure and reporting by reputable breeders of ads that don't meet the new standards will be an important step in the fight to end puppy farming.

CLUB GROUND RULES

These rules apply to all handlers and have been formulated for the welfare of you and your dog.

- Any Club member, or any person guilty of unseemly conduct or acts harmful to the club, may be asked to leave the Club grounds. They may also be dealt with by the Committee of The GSDC of SA Inc. under clause 6, and relative by-laws of the Clubs Constitution.
- Members shall not treat their dog in a manner that may reflect badly on the Club.
- The owner and or handler shall be responsible for their dogs while on club grounds and must accept any liability for animals in their care at all times.
- The handlers of dogs that foul the Club Grounds will be responsible for cleaning up same, with the equipment provided.
- Any dog that is sick **WILL NOT** be permitted onto the Club Grounds.
- Dogs who have suffered a **CONTAGIOUS DISEASE WILL NOT** be allowed on to the Grounds until 5 weeks after being cleared by a veterinarian (a vets certificate may be required). Puppies should not be brought out onto the Club Grounds under the age of 8 weeks or at least 2 weeks after they have been inoculated for **HEPATITIS, DISTEMPER AND PARVOVIRUS** (vaccination certificate may be required).
- The Head Instructor has the authority to permit the use of a muzzle or training devices, as required in special cases. The use of the equipment is to be under supervision, and its use on the Grounds, other than above, is **STRICTLY FORBIDDEN**.
- The use of switches, spiked collars or whips is **STRICTLY FORBIDDEN ON THE CLUB GROUNDS**.
- Dogs are **NOT** to be taken off lead or left unattended, except on the directives, or under the supervision of a Class Instructor.
- Bitches in season are not permitted on the grounds unless at a recognised conformation show.
- Dogs under the age of 12 months **ARE NOT** permitted to use jump equipment higher than 400 mm, or longer than 800 mm.
- The handlers of dogs that foul the Club Grounds will be responsible for cleaning up same, with the equipment provided.
- Pursuant of the Health act "Dogs" **ARE NOT** permitted inside the Club Rooms.
- In the interest of safety and health, and in consideration of others, parents are required to supervise the behaviour of their children. The Club Rooms and Toilets **MUST NOT** be used as playing areas.
- In the interests of public health the Club Rooms and the veranda area are **NON-SMOKING** areas.
- Appropriate foot wear must be worn at **ALL** times when handling/double handling dogs on the Club Grounds. Bare feet, thongs, slip on shoes, high heels, sandals, crocs and shoes with metal-spiked soles (covered or uncovered) are not suitable foot wear and members wearing any of the above will be asked to leave the Club grounds.

Training Extreme Weather Policy

Training will be cancelled if the forecast temperature for **West Beach** is predicted to be 37 degrees or above or an Extreme Storm warning is issued on www.eldersweather.com.au at 6pm the night before training (Wednesday nights and Sunday mornings).
