Symptoms of Dog Heat Stroke

Symptoms of heat stroke in dog include:

Excessive panting Salivation Body temperature of 104° or more Collapse Diarrhea Vomiting Increased, thumping heart rate Depression Stupor or appearing in a daze Seizures Coma

Heatstroke is usually seen in the months between November and March.

Treatment of Dog Heat Stroke

There are several steps that need to be immediately taken:

1. Move your dog to a cool place such as an air conditioned room.

2. Take rectal temperature every 10 minutes to see if it is coming down.

3. If rectal temperature if 40C - 43C cool your dog with cool water from something like a garden hose or bucket, a cool water bath, ice packs applied to the abdomen or groin area or place in front of a fan.

Seek veterinary care immediately for canine heat stroke. Heat stroke can be particularly dangerous if you cannot cool your dog's temperature within 20 minutes

4. Wipe paws with cool water (paws are the only area on a dog that can sweat).

5. Once temperature reaches 39C or less than stop cooling to avoid hypothermia.

A reader recently sent a note recommending a <u>Dog Cooling Jacket</u>. These come in different sizes and rely on either water or gel which is cooled prior to putting them on your dog.

Side Effects of Heat Stroke in Dogs

Heat stroke in dogs can result in a breathing problem called laryngeal edema and hyperthermia (high body temperature). Hyperthermia can result in problems such as kidney disease, bleeding, heart arrhythmia and seizures.

These side effects can set in on the same day or within weeks of heat stroke. Be sure to consult with your veterinarian.

In most dogs if they can survive for 72 hours from the onset of the condition, then they should be fine.

Symptoms of Dog Heat Stroke Continued

Prevention of Canine Heat Stroke

As mentioned, dogs cannot cool themselves on hot days since panting becomes less effective the hotter it gets. This is why it is important not to leave your dog in the car in the summer, even with the window cracked open. A good guideline is to cool your dog or give your dog water when you feel the need for yourself.

The key to heatstroke is to recognize it as early as possible and to immediately begin bringing your dog's body temperature down to 39C.



2nd Vice President's Report

A couple of points of interest coming from the **Nation Council AGM**:

As of July 1st 2017, there will only be Breed Survey Classified, the previous Class I and Class II will cease.

Choice of Surveyor remains

The issue of Size was again raised and was defeated

The Breed Surveyor Service agreement was passed and will come into effect as of July 1st 2017

The GSDC of A Database has been upgraded and it is now possible to search by Sire and Dam. This will assist in allowing members to search for animals from a particular bloodline.

A discussion night will be held on Friday April 7th.. This will be co-ordinated by J Pike and the discussion will be: **"TYPE"**

A breed Survey will be held on Sunday March 19th, Member's Competition on Sunday March 26th, Please note if the Heat policy should come into effect the show will commence at 6.00pm Sunday night.

A meeting will be held on Sunday April 2nd to discuss and decide on the motions which came from the GSDC of A AGM under the Sixty (60) day rule.

OPEN MEETING Sunday April 2nd 2017 11.15am Clubrooms WEST BEACH

Motion No 1. – Moved SA

"That the GSD League be granted the right to host the 2020 GSDCA GSD National Show & Trial providing that the event is held during the period of Mid April to late May but not over the Easter Weekend."

Rationale:

During discussion of which Club would host the 2020 National, it was noted that it would be Sydney. Based on previous Sydney Nationals, with regard to the usually very hot weather and the expense of accommodation at Easter time, the GSD League makes every effort to contact DogsNSW as soon as possible to obtain permission for dates around mid April to late May. Preferably the 3rd weekend in May.

Motion No 2. - Moved SA

"That as 1st January 2018 the only acceptable identification method for participation in all GSDCA Breed Improvement Schemes will be micro chipping and that all GSDCA regulations pertaining to the accepted method of identification are amended accordingly."

Rationale:

The GSDCA Executive had been advised that according to the RSPCA National Policy, the GSDCA are in breach of the rules and that the activity of tattooing our puppies is considered an invasive practice and the drawing blood and causing pain is not recommended.

Issues considered:

Low Numbers now being tattooed. Lack of popularity due to microchipping. Tattooist have not been trained via a recognised training authority. The steralistion process of "autoclave", used by vets, for the tattoo implements is not considered ethical. Welfare of Dogs RSPCA/AVA would not support our practice of tattooing.

Clubs should be aware, that if this motion gets approval, Clubs will have to cease tattooing as it will no longer be recognized as a form of identification for our Breed Improvement Schemes.

CLUB GROUND RULES

These rules apply to all handlers and have been formulated for the welfare of you and your dog.

- Any Club member, or any person guilty of unseemly conduct or acts harmful to the club, may be asked to leave the Club grounds. They may also be dealt with by the Committee of The GSDC of SA Inc. under clause 6, and relative by-laws of the Clubs Constitution.
- Members shall not treat their dog in a manner that may reflect badly on the Club.
- The owner and or handler shall be responsible for their dogs while on club grounds and must accept any liability for animals in their care at all times.
- The handlers of dogs that foul the Club Grounds will be responsible for cleaning up same, with the equipment provided.
- Any dog that is sick WILL NOT be permitted onto the Club Grounds.
- Dogs who have suffered a CONTAGIOUS DISEASE WILL NOT be allowed on to the Grounds until 5 weeks after being cleared by a veterinarian (a vets certificate may be required). Puppies should not be brought out onto the Club Grounds under the age of 8 weeks or at least 2 weeks after they have been inoculated for HEPATITIS, DISTEMPER AND PARVOVIRUS (vaccination certificate may be required).
- The Head Instructor has the authority to permit the use of a muzzle or training devices, as required in special cases. The use of the equipment is to be under supervision, and its use on the Grounds, other than above, is STRICTLY FORBIDDEN.
- The use of switches, spiked collars or whips is STRICTLY FORBIDDEN ON THE CLUB GROUNDS.
- Dogs are NOT to be taken off lead or left unattended, except on the directives, or under the supervision of a Class Instructor.
- Bitches in season are not permitted on the grounds unless at a recognised conformation show.
- Dogs under the age of 12 months ARE NOT permitted to use jump equipment higher than 400 mm, or longer than 800 mm.
- The handlers of dogs that foul the Club Grounds will be responsible for cleaning up same, with the equipment provided.
- Pursuant of the Health act "Dogs" ARE NOT permitted inside the Club Rooms.
- In the interest of safety and health, and in consideration of others, parents are required to supervise the behaviour of their children. The Club Rooms and Toilets MUST NOT be used as playing areas.
- In the interests of public health the Club Rooms and the veranda area are NON-SMOKING areas.
- Appropriate foot wear must be worn at ALL times when handling/double handling dogs on the Club Grounds. Bare feet, thongs, slip on shoes, high heels, sandals, crocs and shoes with metal-spiked soles (covered or uncovered) are not suitable foot wear and members wearing any of the above will be asked to leave the Club grounds.

Training Extreme Weather Policy

Training will be cancelled if the forecast temperature for <u>West Beach</u> is predicted to be 37 degrees or above or an Extreme Storm warning is issued on <u>www.eldersweather.com.au</u> at 6pm the night before training (Wednesday nights and Sunday mornings).
