

PRESIDENTS YOUTH HANDLER TROPHY.

- There shall be a trophy called “The Presidents Youth Handler Trophy”
- Categories: 7 to under 10 years;
10 to under 13 years;
13 to under 18 years
- There will be three trophies each year, one for each category. This competition is combined boys and girls.
- **Eligibility:** To compete for the trophy and participate in the event persons must be members of the GSDC of SA Inc. or is a member of an affiliate of the GSDC of A Inc. To compete on the day of the event, visitors may participate as long as there is a parent or guardian present and a gold coin donation is provided.
- The trophies will be awarded to the boy **or** girl in each category gaining the highest number of points at specialty shows conducted by the GSDC of SA in the calendar year.
- The specified shows may include but not limited to the Open Show and the Championship Show and allocated member competitions. There will be a minimum total of three shows. The shows will be selected at the start of the year.
- Points will be allocated as follows:-
 - 3 points for first place
 - 2 points for second place
 - 1 point for third place
- Should two or more candidates have equal points; the winner will be determined by count back of scores.
- A small encouragement prizewill be given to each entrant at the time of competing.
- The trophies will be presented at the Presentation day/night each year.
