Breed Affairs Report—Christine Collins

We have had a couple of busy months.

Congratulations to those animals and owners that were presented for breed survey.

Congratulations to all those owners and animals that were successful at our recent members competition under Mrs M Groth

The National Council Breed Commission meeting was held in Adelaide. Some points of interest from the meetings are:

It was agreed by those Judges present that animals that measure over 62 cm (Females) and 67cm (Males) will be penalised a grading. It was also agreed that over angulated animals and those with very loose hocks should also be penalised. Animals with excessive hind quarter angulations are to be made Class II, this will assist in combating the looseness of the hind quarters.

Please note the next Breed Survey will be held on **Sunday 25th October 2015**, 12 noon.

Entries must be in 12 noon 18th October.

The Breed Survey Work sheet has been improved upon, including adding the tail and neck and removing some of the descriptive words that are no longer used.

Also all breeders are to be more vigilant in checking microchip numbers on their animals pedigree once they are returned from the Controlling Body. Ensure there are 15 numbers.

It is not recommended at this time to instigate a scheme for DNA testing for Degenerative Myelopathy. The numbers are small and inconclusive. And the disease can only be identified with a post-mortem. R Zammitt and K Hedberg advised that most animals are diagnosed without positive proof and could have Lumbosacral Stenosis, Spondylosis

Dr Robert Zammitt is investigating the DNA of Hip Dysplasia and is doing a trial study. He needs to get 1000 samples of blood and swabs from dogs that have been HD x-rayed pass or fail. Dr Zammitt will travel to Adelaide to collect DNA samples in the near future and we will keep you informed of the date.

Show training on Sunday will start at 10am from October 11th this will allow plenty of time for puppy class as well as the adult class. A big thank you to all the people that have volunteered to take show class. And can I remind you that if you are unable to take class it is your responsibility to find a replacement.

A Training manual has been developed for the Conformation ring, and any member wishing to assist with the Show Class are advised to request a copy of the manual.

Joylene Neddermeyer has agreed to do a lecture on Bloodlines for us on October 11th. come along and enjoy a BBQ and a very interesting lecture.



GROUND RULES

These rules apply to all handlers during training sessions and have been formulated for the welfare of you and your dog.

Any Club member, or any person guilty of unseemly conduct or acts harmful to the club, may be asked to leave the Training area. They may also be dealt with by the Committee of The GSDC of S A Inc. under clause 6, and relative by-laws of the Clubs Constitution.

Any dog which is sick WILL NOT be permitted onto the Club grounds.

Dogs who have suffered a CONTAGIOUS DISEASE WILL NOT be allowed on to the grounds until 5 weeks after being cleared by a veterinarian (a vets certificate may be required). Puppies should not be brought out onto the Club grounds under the age of 8 weeks or at least 2 weeks after they have been inoculated for HEPATITIS, DISTEMPER AND PARVOVIRUS (vaccination certificate may be required).

Bitches in season are not permitted on the grounds unless at a recognised Club event.

The use of switches, spiked collars or whips is STRICTLY FORBIDDEN ON THE CLUB GROUNDS.

Members shall not treat their dog in a manner which may reflect badly on the Club.

Dogs are NOT to be taken off-lead or left unattended, except on the directives, or under the supervision of a Class Instructor.

The handlers of dogs which foul the Club grounds, will be responsible for cleaning up same, with the equipment provided.

The Head Instructor has the authority to permit the use of a muzzle or training devices, as required in special cases. The use of the equipment is to be under supervision, and its use on the grounds, other than above, is STRICTLY FORBIDDEN.

Dogs under the age of 12 months ARE NOT permitted to use jump equipment higher than 400 mm, or longer than 800 mm.

Pursuant of the Health act "Dogs" ARE NOT permitted inside the Clubrooms.

In the interest of safety and health, and in consideration of others, parents are required to supervise the behaviour of their children. The Clubrooms and Toilets MUST NOT be used as playing areas.

In the interests of public health the Clubrooms and the verandah area are NON-SMOKING areas.

TRAINING HEAT POLICY If the forecast temperature is predicted to be 38 degrees or above on channel 9 weather at 6pm the night before training, (Wednesday nights or Sundays), all training will be cancelled.

Appropriate foot wear must be worn at ALL times when handling / double handling dogs on the Club grounds. Bare feet, thongs, slip on shoes, high heels, sandals or crocs are not suitable foot wear and members wearing any of the above will be asked to leave the training area.
