ENTRY FEES: <u>Members</u> - Junior, Intermediate and Open - \$30-00 per class Baby, Minor and Puppy - \$20-00 per class.

Catalogue - \$5-00. <u>NOT INCLUDED IN ENTRY FEE.</u> Please order separately. One catalogue covers both shows.

**Non members** – double the above entry fees. All interstate competitors who are members of their local GSD clubs will be given honorary membership for these events.

**BREEDER'S GROUP :** To be judged on Sunday first class after the lunch break. Breeders may enter as many teams as desired. All animals must carry the breeder's prefix and be of one coat variety. Each team must consist of 5 animals over 6 months of age from at least 2 sires and 2 dams. A separate entry form for each team must be received by the closing date of entries – no entry fee. Details of animals competing must be handed to the Show Manager by 12 noon on Sunday 10/6/18. All animals listed in a Breeder's Group must be entered in the show on Sunday.

AwARDS: Trophy & Sash to Best In Show, both Best of Breeds, all Challenge Dogs, Challenge Bitches and all Class winners. Sashes only to 2<sup>nd</sup> to 6<sup>th</sup> places in each class, where numbers permit. GSDCA Excellent medallions will be awarded at the judge's discretion to animals that have been successfully breed surveyed and are exhibited in the Open classes.

**Perpetual Trophies**: Replicas of the "Vonpeta Kennels Best In Show Trophy" will be presented on both days; the <u>"Rov Brabham Memorial Trophy"</u> replicas will be presented to stock coat Challenge Dog & stock coat Challenge Bitch winners on Saturday only. A replica of the <u>"SA</u> <u>Breeders Group"</u> trophy will be presented to the winning kennel on Sunday.

Results from these two Championship Shows, together with the two Championship Shows held in November (Victorian Working Dog Club weekend) will count towards the <u>"Terry Shaw Memorial State of Origin Trophy"</u>. Rules available from the Secretary's office over the weekend.

**CRITIQUES :** For Junior, Intermediate & Open classes only will be available on the Club's website <u>gsdcsa.org.au</u> as soon as possible after the event. Grading certificates for all classes will be available.

**PRESIDENT'S YOUTH TROPHY COMPETTION :** Entries will be taken on the day. <u>Classes</u> - 7 to under 10 years; 10 to under 13 years; 13 to under 18 years. Medallions (donated by Alimanda Kennels) will be presented in the clubrooms at the conclusion of all judging on Saturday to all participants. This is a qualifying Show for the SA "PRESIDENT'S YOUTH TROPHY", to be presented at the end of the year. <u>No adults will be permitted in the ring. All children</u> <u>must have control of the animal they are exhibiting.</u> If any child cannot solely control (hold) the animal they are exhibiting they may be asked to leave.

### **Obedience Report**

It is hard to believe how quickly this year is passing, but here we are again in the cooler weather when it is just great to be out and about with our dogs. We are experiencing high attendance at our classes with a broad mixture of handlers of all ages.

The instructors are very keen to promote strong bonds between handlers and their dogs. We like to hear them interacting with their canine companions, giving clear commands and working at forming a team with their dog. Dogs like to hear your voice and want to please you.

Learn to read your dog and listen to what he says to you. Just because he doesn't have words doesn't mean he can't communicate. A handler needs to be the leader and be firm and fair with their shepherd and will be rewarded with an abundance of unconditional love and loyalty.

Some of you may have noticed our new setup where the beginners ring is next to the trial ring. This is working well, it allows beginners to watch the more experienced dogs working with Ingrid. This can be an incentive for them, all their hard work will pay off in the end and they shouldn't get disheartened with how their novice dogs work.

All the dogs in the trial ring were also beginners once. Another class that is working very well is our new advanced trials class. We are encouraging more handlers in this class to enter obedience trials, and at the recent National Show we had four members pass their trials. So congratulations to them for a sterling effort. This may not seem a lot when compared to ten years ago, but times have changed. T rials no longer attract the same numbers as in the past. It is also hard in today's fast paced world for people to find the time to train their dogs to this level and enter trials, with so many other demands in their busy lives.

Obedience training is not just about trials, and some people would never wish to enter one for whatever reason. However, it is about training your dog to be well behaved and a good representative of the German Shepherd breed.

Sharing a bond with your dog, sharing experiences, and being able to take him with you anywhere knowing he is under control, and you will both have happy enjoyable times together.

There are new laws for dog and cats in South Australia, including new microchipping and desexing requirements. These changes will improve the welfare and management of dogs and cats in the community.

STRIEMGER 2017

#### The biggest changes:

#### From 1 July 2017:

Increased fines and explations for breaking the law (dog attacks, etc).

Increased council powers to investigate and prosecute breaches of the law.

#### From 1 July 2018:

BOG AND CATREFORMS VOD

- All dogs and cats over 12 weeks of age to be microchipped.
- All new generations of dogs and cats (born after 1 July 2018) to be desexed. Exemptions apply for working dogs, registered breeders etc.

These changes will increase the likelihood of lost or impounded dogs and cats being reunited with their owners, and reduce the number of unwanted and abandoned litters euthanised in pounds and shelters.

#### **Discount Microchipping**

Microchipping is a safe and permanent way to identify your dog and cat. The procedure is quick, with no ongoing discomfort, and can only be carried out by a trained, authorised implanter.

Discount microchipping days are offered throughout the state at various times of the year. Visit **chipblitz.com** for more.

#### New rules for Breeders and Sellers

- From 1 August 2017, all breeders and sellers must meet new industry standards and guidelines, to comply with the state's animal welfare laws.
- From 1 July 2018, breeders must register with the Dog and Cat Management Board. In exchange, they will be issued with a registration number that must be provided, along with up-to-date contact details in all advertisements. This new accountability will help weed-out unscrupulous traders from the business.

These changes affect anyone who breeds dogs or cats for sale or trade, not just pedigree breeders.

#### Greater powers for councils

Councils play a vital role in dog and cat management in your community. They are responsible for registration, collection and return of stray dogs, and investigating complaints of barking or dog attacks.

For this reason, councils have new powers under the revised laws, including the ability to gather evidence, and compel dog or cat owners to give their name and address. This will help councils combat various problems, including dog attacks.

There are also increases in some explations and penalties to encourage good dog and cat owner behaviour.

#### DACO - a new way to register your dog or cat

From 1 July 2018, dog and cat registration, along with the way you manage your pet dog or cat's microchip, desexing and breeder information, will be simplified with the introduction of a new website.

Dogs and Cats Online (DACO) will be the central point for all your dog and cat management payments and information, bringing together data currently held on 68 individual council systems and private microchip catabases.

Not only will DACO simplify your dog or cat management needs, but it will streamline the process for councils, vets and animal welfare agencies too, giving these organisations instant access to information from around the state. This will help them reunite you and your lost dog or cat quicker.

#### Does microchipping replace council registration?

No. Microchipping is a great form of ID, but council registration funds all the important dog and cat management activities in your local area, including dog parks, poo bags, dog pounds, returning lost dogs, investigating dog attacks and other duties carried out by animal management officers.

#### Changes to dog registration categories

As of 2017, dog registration in South Australia has been simplified. Your dog now falls under one of these two simple categories.

Standard Dog: A dog that is both desexed and microchipped

Non-standard Dog: all other dogs, even if they are exempt from rules around desexing or microchipping, such as dogs belonging to registered breeders, working livestock dogs etc.

These changes have been made so registration categories throughout the state can be streamlined. Your council may still offer additional rebates. Speak to them to see what rebates might apply to you.

#### About the Dog and Cat Management Board

Established in 1995 under The *Dog* and *Cot* Monagement Act, the Dog and Cat Management Board is the only statutory board of its kind in Australia and works closely with key partner organisations and the State Government to improve dog and cat management in South Australia.

Using its research and expertise the Board has ensured that South Australia's regulatory and legislative framework has been reviewed and amended to improve the management of dogs and cats in South Australia.

The Board was a key driver of the reforms now being introduced and will take a proactive role in their application. Including the new requirement for breeders to be registered and in the roll-out of DACO.



#### **GROUND RULES**

These rules apply to all handlers during training sessions and have been formulated for the welfare of you and your dog.

Any Club member, or any person guilty of unseemly conduct or acts harmful to the club, may be asked to leave the Training area. They may also be dealt with by the Committee of The GSDC of S A Inc. under clause 6, and relative by-laws of the Clubs Constitution.

Any dog which is sick WILL NOT be permitted onto the Club grounds.

Dogs who have suffered a CONTAGIOUS DISEASE WILL NOT be allowed on to the grounds until 5 weeks after being cleared by a veterinarian (a vets certificate may be required). Puppies should not be brought out onto the Club grounds under the age of 8 weeks or at least 2 weeks after they have been inoculated for HEPATITIS, DISTEMPER AND PARVOVIRUS (vaccination certificate may be required).

Bitches in season are not permitted on the grounds unless at a recognised Club event.

The use of switches, spiked collars or whips is STRICTLY FORBIDDEN ON THE CLUB GROUNDS.

Members shall not treat their dog in a manner which may reflect badly on the Club.

Dogs are NOT to be taken off-lead or left unattended, except on the directives, or under the supervision of a Class Instructor.

The handlers of dogs which foul the Club grounds, will be responsible for cleaning up same, with the equipment provided.

The Head Instructor has the authority to permit the use of a muzzle or training devices, as required in special cases. The use of the equipment is to be under supervision, and its use on the grounds, other than above, is STRICTLY FORBIDDEN.

Dogs under the age of 12 months ARE NOT permitted to use jump equipment higher than 400 mm, or longer than 800 mm.

Pursuant of the Health act "Dogs" ARE NOT permitted inside the Clubrooms.

In the interest of safety and health, and in consideration of others, parents are required to super-vise the behaviour of their children. The Clubrooms and Toilets MUST NOT be used as playing areas.

In the interests of public health the Clubrooms and the verandah area are NON-SMOKING areas.

#### **Training Extreme Weather Policy**

Training will be cancelled if the forecast temperature for <u>West Beach</u> is predicted to be 37 degrees or above or an Extreme Storm warning is issued on <u>www.eldersweather.com.au</u> at 6pm the night before training (Wednesday nights and Sunday mornings).

Appropriate foot wear must be worn at ALL times when handling / double handling dogs on the Club grounds. Bare feet, thongs, slip on shoes, high heels, sandals or crocs and shoes with metal-spiked soles are not suitable foot wear and mem-

bers wearing any of the above will be asked to leave the training area.
