

Meet The Breeder

This is the first of a series of articles to come interviewing the Breeders and Instructors of the club so that you the members can get to know them a little better. This interview was with Gail Wellman of Taurorn Kennels. We hope you enjoy this series over the coming editions!

I. When did you purchase your first German Shepherd Dog?

Wow -let me think - I purchased my first German Shepherd in the mid/late 70s from a girl that I worked with- not a breeder! I had always wanted a German Shepherd for as long as I could remember, but was not allowed one as a child, so as soon as I got married I was determined to get one. When I found out that she had a litter I went to have a look and no prizes for what happened upon seeing them. I hadn't any thoughts on male or female but when I looked at the pups there was a little girl that looked just like a little werewolf – "butt ugly but sorta" cute" and a great character. Tara, as she was called, went on to become one of South Australia's highest obedience achievers. My first "Show" German Shepherd- Ch Pejanka Uschi- came from Pejanka Kennels - Betty McMonagle- who along with Sue Bruno encouraged me into the Show ring and were great mentors.

2. What was your first discipline?

I started in Obedience at Noarlunga City Obedience Dog Club. At that time there was still a lot of prejudice towards German Shepherds and I wanted to make sure that Tara was a well behaved girl that I could take anywhere with confidence. We both loved our involvement in the Obedience world – Tara excelled and gained all her titles – CD – CDX – UD & UDX – winning many trophies and many first placings and was in the Demonstration Team and I became an Instructor and went on to become the first female Head Instructor at Noarlunga City.

3. How did you come up with your kennel name, "Taurorn", what does it mean? The name Taurorn is actually a combination of two star signs – Taurus and Capricorn

4. In what year was Taurorn Kennels established?

Taurorn Kennels was established in 1988 by myself and then partner Brian Fielder. We had our first litter in November 1988.

5. What is your preference – specialty ring or all breed ring and why?

I would have to say that I don't have a preference for either. Both rings are two completely different disciplines in my mind but in having said that I do feel a better sense of achievement when competing in the Speciality ring -being judged/critiqued by specialists for your breed and as a breeder being able to see that your breeding is "heading in the right direction" has got to be a plus. I do feel however that it is important to show our dogs in the All Breeds environment as well, as it gives the "other breeds" exhibitors/

judges a chance to see our breed and how it is progressing and it is usually where the general public sees German Shepherds. It is still quite amazing at the misconceptions about the breed and the continued argument about "type" – straight back/slope back – that are still prevalent. I suspect there will always be the All Breeds versus Speciality argument but luckily here in SA it is mostly the Members from the German Shepherd Club that show in the All breeds ring!

6. What is your most memorable moment during your breeding career?

There are actually 3 occasions that I can recall -each firsts, very memorable and rewarding. My first time in a major Specialty show here in Adelaide -1990 Main Breed Show-when I exhibited Ch.Pejanka Uschi who up till then had only been shown in All Breeds. She was at the end of her class -Open Bitch - and the judge kept moving her up and up and I kept wondering what was wrong until I was told that it was a good thing!! She ended up being placed 20 from a class of 56, with a fantastic critique and I nearly had a heart attack! 2nd occasion was when my first homebred animal from my 2nd litter-Taurorn Babooshka-owned by Pat and Terry Shaw from Elvarado Kennels -was placed 3rd in the Open Bitch Class at the 1992 Nationals. And of course the 'biggie'winning the Gold Medal/Challenge Dog at the 2018 National with our boy - Trooper - *Ch.Sundaneka Young Gun A $\overset{\cdot}{Z}$ – a true OMG moment!!! A dream fulfilled!!

7. How do you think the breed has changed since you started Taurorn Kennels?

We've certainly moved away from the old "English" style of Shepherd that was so typical in the earlier days- swan neck, very straight back and stuffy and definitely the German bloodlines have had a major influence on "todays" dog. Whilst this has been a good thing, with improvements in pigment, better eye colour and I feel a better consolidation of type, I believe the down side is of course our continued size issue - a subject that will always be highly "debated" and of late the over angulation of hindquarters which unfortunately does give the general populace the wrong idea of the "look" of a German Shepherd. Underjaw strength, depth of chest -all presenting issues -and I believe that we have lost strength in head of our males and our bitches are becoming fine and have lost that "brood bitch" quality. We need to remember what the German Shepherd was bred for - working - and also to look at the benefits that our Australian bred dogs can bring to the breed - a predictability of well known and proven bloodlines. I think

breeders can be too quick to use the latest import (I've done it myself!!) – of which there are many now – without waiting and actually seeing what they are producing. I do feel that we have made major improvements in the general health of the German Shepherd through our various breed schemes and I believe that the general public has far more confidence now in buying a German Shepherd as apposed to 10-15 years ago.

8. Do you have a favourite Tourorn dog? This is a toughie - is it your first bred pups who gain their hip/elbow status - your first Champion/Breed Surveyed/Excellent gained -I'd like to say they are all special but I don't think anyone ever forgets their first Shepherd- in my case my Tara- she certainly wasn't well bred but as an introduction to the breed- especially to their intelligence and working capabilities, for me she was a gem. As the "foundation" bitch of my kennels -Ch.Pejanka Uschi holds a special spot - such a loving and gentle girl as well as a great producer and of course my Troop-Ch.Sundaneka Young Gun – such a pleasure to have this dog in my kennels- great companion and mate - love him to bits!! You can win trophy after trophy, gain those placings and have winner after winner but in the end it's about having a great companion and a great ambassador for the breed.

9. What advice would you give to those

starting off a breeding kennel?
Quality – try to get the best quality bitch and genetics that you can afford, as your foundation stock and don't skimp. Research your bloodlines and have an idea of where you are going and why you want to breed. Be prepared for ups and downs. Have a good mentor and pick their brains and always be open to questioning and most of all – love your animals and enjoy what you are doing.
When the fun goes out of it give it up!

10. What is your vision for the future? I would hope to be able to continue breeding as I have been and to continue to enjoy what I do-it would be great to breed a Gold Medal winner under my Prefix – LOL. I have had some great times over the years with my dogs and have enjoyed many friendships through them and that's what it is all about! I do have concerns with Harmonisation as to exactly what effect it will have on the breed – one hopes that it will not' divide" the breed but time will tell on that one!

The test is open to dogs aged between two (2) and under eight (8) years but must not have reached the birth date of eight (8) on the day of the trial. A veterinary certificate, issued within fourteen (14) days immediately prior to the date of the test, must be submitted for each dog on the day. It shall cover such things as the general fitness, temperature, standing heart rate, condition of the pads and muscle tone of the dog (for bitches the certificate is to also state also that the bitch is not in whelp).

Preparing Your Dog For an Endurance Test

A note from the vet.

To ensure you and your dog complete the Endurance Trial, I have written some suggestions to help you succeed.

From my experience, the most common reasons dogs are withdrawn during the event are from overheating/lack of fitness or pad issues. All dogs participating in the event need endurance training at and above the speed the event is run (10kph). Chasing balls, running around the backyard and long walks should **not** be considered adequate training!

Most of the course is on bitumen, which is abrasive and hard on pads, so much of the training should be done on bitumen to allow the pads to adapt. Always check your dog's pads after each training session to make sure they are OK. If the pads are not coping then continue training on softer surfaces before increasing time spent on bitumen.

Heavy breeds & overweight dogs will find the test tough, so will need good preparation to complete it comfortably. Even though the event is run during the cooler months, the sun can be out and larger dogs may overheat, especially if they have not had adequate training. Artificial cooling is not permitted.

Those with small dogs should prepare for cold weather by bringing coats to keep the dogs (and yourself) warm during the breaks, especially if it is raining and windy.

The article referenced below by Carole Bryant on preparing your dog is the best I could find on the internet. If you use it as a guide your dog should be able to complete the event (and then some more!).

The only comment I would like to make is that in human endurance sports, the tapering period (the time one reduces the amount of training before the event) begins about 10 days prior to the event, whereas Carole suggests only a few days. I'll let you decide what's best for your dog! Please note that in SA attaching dogs directly to your bike and riding on public footpaths/roads with your dog is not permitted.

GROUND RULES

These rules apply to all handlers during training sessions and have been formulated for the welfare of you and your dog.

Any Club member, or any person guilty of unseemly conduct or acts harmful to the club, may be asked to leave the Training area. They may also be dealt with by the Committee of The GSDC of S A Inc. under clause 6, and relative by-laws of the Clubs Constitution.

Any dog which is sick WILL NOT be permitted onto the Club grounds.

Dogs who have suffered a CONTAGIOUS DISEASE WILL NOT be allowed on to the grounds until 5 weeks after being cleared by a veterinarian (a vets certificate may be required). Puppies should not be brought out onto the Club grounds under the age of 8 weeks or at least 2 weeks after they have been inoculated for HEPATITIS, DISTEMPER AND PARVOVIRUS (vaccination certificate may be required).

Bitches in season are not permitted on the grounds unless at a recognised Club event.

The use of switches, spiked collars or whips is STRICTLY FORBIDDEN ON THE CLUB GROUNDS.

Members shall not treat their dog in a manner which may reflect badly on the Club.

Dogs are NOT to be taken off-lead or left unattended, except on the directives, or under the supervision of a Class Instructor.

The handlers of dogs which foul the Club grounds, will be responsible for cleaning up same, with the equipment provided.

The Head Instructor has the authority to permit the use of a muzzle or training devices, as required in special cases. The use of the equipment is to be under supervision, and its use on the grounds, other than above, is STRICTLY FORBIDDEN.

Dogs under the age of 12 months ARE NOT permitted to use jump equipment higher than 400 mm, or longer than 800 mm.

Pursuant of the Health act "Dogs" ARE NOT permitted inside the Clubrooms.

In the interest of safety and health, and in consideration of others, parents are required to super-vise the behaviour of their children. The Clubrooms and Toilets MUST NOT be used as playing areas.

In the interests of public health the Clubrooms and the verandah area are NON-SMOKING areas.

Training Extreme Weather Policy

Training will be cancelled if the forecast temperature for <u>West Beach</u> is predicted to be 37 degrees or above or an Extreme Storm warning is issued on <u>www.eldersweather.com.au</u> at 6pm the night before training (Wednesday nights and Sunday mornings).

Appropriate foot wear must be worn at ALL times when handling / double handling dogs on the Club grounds. Bare feet, thongs, slip on shoes, high heels, sandals or crocs and shoes with metal-spiked soles are not suitable foot wear and members wearing any of the above will be asked to leave the training area.
