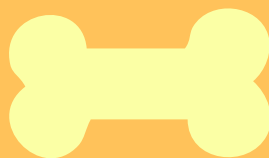
Another calendar year has already started, while this edition is later than I'd hoped it has been a slow burn putting it together.

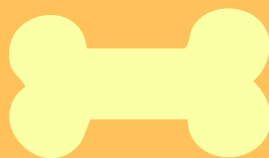

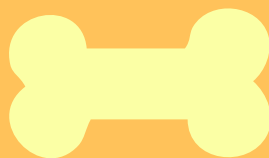
Planning has already commenced for the 2024 National Show and Trial to be hosted by our club.

# Breed Affairs Report

This is my first report as the 2nd Vice President and although it hasn't been long since the AGM, there has still been a lot happening.

Since the last Shepherd News, the Open Show was held in November, judged by Ms R Jamieson, a group 5 trainee judge. Thank you to the members who entered and supported the Open Show. These shows are invaluable for trainee judges to get hands on experience with German Shepherds and every time I speak to a non-GSD judge that has done one of our Open Shows, they say afterwards how much they enjoyed it and learnt.

Congratulations to the winners: \*Leppsdorf Mystic Myrah 'A' 'Z' – Best LSC Bitch, Sup Ch Vonpeta No Harmonization 'A' 'Z' – Best SC Bitch, \*Ch Vonpeta Qwackawoody 'A' 'Z' – Best LSC Dog and Ch Vonpeta Ess Eff Aay (AI) 'A' 'Z' – Best SC Dog.

Early in January an Open Breed Affairs Meeting was held. Understandably, not all Show and Breeding members were able to attend, but a huge thank you to those that could. I felt it was a very productive meeting, with excellent discussion. We were able to discuss several items and the meeting gave clear direction on where the members wanted the club to be moving towards.

Judging format for Members Competitions will be going back to stopping run-offs after Best Dog and Bitch; that means no inter-sex or inter-variety run-offs. The first show of this year will be moving to a Saturday Night show.

Next year with the National, we will hold one less Members Competition. Members were also able to suggest judges they would like to see for next year and lastly, from the next financial year (once approved by committee) a puppy point score will be run. More details to come on this later, once they're finalized and approved by committee. Thank you to Vondoussa and Kyndom Kennels who have already offered to sponsor these trophies.

On the 15th of January, we held our annual 'Puppy Day'. The weather was perfect for the day and the puppies had a blast being able to play with each other and run around off-lead in a controlled, safe environment. There were 36 puppies that attended ranging from 3 to 9 months of age.

## JUDGING TIMES

### FRIDAY 28<sup>TH</sup> APRIL 2023

**CONFORMATION:** Vest collection from 7.00am. Judging commences at 8.00 am.

**Bitch Ring:** SC Baby, Minor and Junior Bitches.

**Dog/LSC Ring:** LSC Baby, Minor and Junior Bitches, then LSC Baby, Minor and Junior Dogs followed by SC Baby, Minor and Junior Dogs.

**RALLY:** Vetting/Check in 9.00-9.30 am. All judging commences at 10.00 am. All place sashes, Excellent medals and mementos will be presented at the conclusion of the Trial. *\*All class winners with qualifying scores must attend the trophy presentations at completion of conformation judging on Sunday, 30<sup>th</sup> April 2023. GSDCA rules apply to all awards and gradings.*

**JUNIOR SHOWMANSHIP** – classes will be judged by Ms. Chelsea Bird (NSW) during lunch break. Ages 7 to under 10 years of age, 10 to under 13 Years, 13 to under 19 Years. Entry and Photo Release forms available from Show Secretary ([show@gsdca.org.au](mailto:show@gsdca.org.au)) or the Show Secretary's office on the day. Entry is free. Entry form and release must be handed to the Show Secretary by 11.00 am Friday 28<sup>th</sup> April 2023. Parents must sign the release form, or the entry will be denied. If a child cannot solely control the animal they are exhibiting they may be asked to leave the ring. No adults will be permitted in the ring.

### SATURDAY 29<sup>TH</sup> APRIL 2023

**CONFORMATION:** Sire's Progeny assembly 7.15 am, parade commences at 8.00 am SHARP in the Dog/LSC ring, to be followed by judging of Breeders Groups. Conformation judging will then follow.

**Bitch Ring:** SC Puppy and Intermediate Bitches.

**Dog /LSC Ring:** LSC Puppy and Intermediate Bitches then LSC Puppy and Intermediate Dogs, SC Puppy and Intermediate Dogs.

**OBEDIENCE:** Vetting/check in from 8.00 to 8.30 am. All judging commences 9.00 am for Community Companion Dog, Open, Utility Dog and Utility Dog Excellent. The Novice class will commence after the Utility Dog Excellent class has completed. All place sashes, Excellent medals and mementos will be presented at the conclusion of the Trial. Winner of Winners will be judged in the Dog/LSC Show Ring on Sunday 30<sup>th</sup> April 2023 during the lunch break (CCD\*, Novice, Open, Utility & UDX class winners with qualifying scores. *\*CCD optional as must compete off lead. \*All class winners with qualifying scores must attend the trophy presentations at completion of conformation judging on Sunday, 30<sup>th</sup> April 2023. GSDCA Rules apply to all awards and gradings.*

**Judging in all rings to cease at 12.00 noon, for the Official Opening ceremony and presentation of GSDCA awards.**

### SUNDAY 30<sup>TH</sup> APRIL 2023

**CONFORMATION:** Commencing at 8.00 am.

**Bitch Ring:** SC Open Bitches.

**Dog/LSC Ring:** LSC Open Bitches, LSC Open Dogs, SC Open Dogs, followed by all Challenges. *\*No Inter-sex or inter-variety judging. Judging in both rings to cease at*

**lunch time for the Winner of Winners Obedience competition, to be held in the Dog/LSC Ring.**

Gun testing may be conducted in all Open classes.

The 49<sup>th</sup> National Show & Trial trophy presentations will be held following the completion of judging.

## EXHIBITORS PLEASE NOTE

- It is your responsibility to ensure you are ready when called to enter the ring.
- Exhibitors will be held responsible for the return of their allocated vests. Any vests not returned within 7 days of the event will incur a \$50.00 fee per unreturned vest.
- Only persons with authorised passes will be permitted to enter the rings.

## SCHEDULE OF CLASSES

Conformation: Stock Coat and Long Stock Coat (ANKC classes 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, & 11 dogs/1a, 2a, 3a, 4a, 5a, 11a bitches). Baby Puppy - 3 months and under 6 months, Minor Puppy – 6 months and under 9 months, Puppy – 6 months and under 12 months, Junior – 9 months and under 18 months, Intermediate – 18 months and under 36 months, Open – 6 months and over. (Ages apply from the first day of the show, 28 April 2023).

## RETIRING ANIMALS

Animals eligible to retire at the National GSD Show and Trial will be: Gold, Silver & Bronze medal winners, National Challenge and Reserve Challenge winners and National GSD Show and Trial Class winners. (*\*For full details and requirements refer to Section 36, National Show Manual on GSDCA website.*)

## SPECIAL CLASS REQUIREMENTS

**Sire's Progeny Parade:** Entry is automatic. A minimum of five progeny aged nine months or over and entered in the Conformation Classes, both SC and LSC, will be automatically catalogued with the Sire's name and exhibit number. The Sire need not be present or entered in the show. *\*The classes are non-competitive but will receive commentary. Only sires classified under the GSDCA Breed Survey Scheme are eligible.*

**Breeders Groups:** Breeders may enter more than one group. All animals must carry the breeder's prefix. Each group must consist of 5 animals over 9 months of age from at least 2 sires and 2 dams and be of one coat variety. All animals listed in a Breeder's Group must be entered in the show. A separate entry form for each team must be received by the closing date of entries - no entry fee. Details of animals competing must be handed to the Show Secretary by close of judging on Friday 28<sup>th</sup> April 2023.

**GSDCA Member Clubs Obedience Challenge:** Teams of four exhibits compete, with the scores gained in their respective classes within the National Trial. Exhibits can be mixed from different obedience classes. Team details including handlers and dogs' names must be provided to the Trial Manager prior to the start of the Trial. At least three of the exhibits must qualify. Exhibits entered in more than one class must nominate which class is to be scored. The winning team is that which has the highest aggregate qualifying scores.

Plaque & sash for all class winners and Breeders Group winner. Sash & memento for 2<sup>nd</sup> to 10<sup>th</sup> place in each class where numbers permit. Trophy & sash for all Challenge Winners.

**OBEDIENCE:** The **Rick Richardson** memorial plaque and a trophy will be awarded to the Winner of Winners.

Gold, Silver & Bronze medals awarded to 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> & 3<sup>rd</sup> in Winner of Winners run off.

Plaque & sash for all class winners. Sash & memento for 2<sup>nd</sup> to 5<sup>th</sup> places in each class.

**DUAL PERFORMANCE:** The **David O'Rourke** memorial plaque and a trophy and sash will be awarded to the best Dual Performance exhibit in the Show and Trial. (Rules may be viewed at the Show Secretary's office over the weekend).

## GRADINGS

**CONFORMATION:** Gradings will be awarded at the Judge's discretion. 'Promising' and 'Very Promising' in Baby, Minor & Puppy Classes. 'Good' and 'Very Good' to animals over 12 months in Junior, Intermediate and Open Classes. \*The grading of 'Excellent' and National Excellent medal will be awarded as per GSDCA rules only to exhibits 2 years of age or over, entered in the Open Classes and classified under the GSDCA Breed Survey Scheme (or other GSDCA approved scheme).

**OBEDIENCE AND RALLY:** Gradings will be awarded to exhibits achieving qualifying scores as per the GSDCA National Trial Manual 7.1.6 and detailed in full in the catalogue.

Excellent medals will be awarded to exhibits obtaining a score of 190 or more in Novice, Open, Utility and UDX classes, or 95 or more in CCD and Rally classes.

## PHOTOGRAPHS AND CRITIQUES

Results and critiques will be published in the Quarterly National Review. An official photographer will be present at the venue and will photograph all conformation place getters.

**Exhibitors** may supply their own photograph to the National Review Editor within 15 days of the event. Refer to the Editor's requirements printed in the catalogue.

**All Obedience and Rally competitors are requested to present themselves and dogs for photos at time of trial check-in.**

## GROUND RULES

These rules apply to all handlers during training sessions and have been formulated for the welfare of you and your dog.

Any Club member, or any person guilty of unseemly conduct or acts harmful to the club, may be asked to leave the Training area.

They may also be dealt with by the Committee of The GSDC of S A Inc. under clause 6, and relative by-laws of the Clubs Constitution.

Any dog which is sick WILL NOT be permitted onto the Club grounds.

Dogs who have suffered a CONTAGIOUS DISEASE WILL NOT be allowed on to the grounds until 5 weeks after being cleared by a veterinarian (a vets certificate may be required).

Puppies should not be brought out onto the Club grounds under the age of 8 weeks or at least 2 weeks after they have been inoculated for HEPATITIS, DISTEMPER AND PARVOVIRUS ( vaccination certificate may be required).

Bitches in season are not permitted on the grounds unless at a recognised Club event. The use of switches, spiked collars or whips is STRICTLY FORBIDDEN ON THE CLUB GROUNDS.

Members shall not treat their dog in a manner which may reflect badly on the Club. Dogs are NOT to be taken off-lead or left unattended, except on the directives, or under the supervision of a Class Instructor.

The handlers of dogs which foul the Club grounds, will be responsible for cleaning up same, with the equipment provided. The Head Instructor has the authority to permit the use of a muzzle or training devices, as required in special cases. The use of the equipment is to be under supervision, and its use on the grounds, other than above, is STRICTLY FORBIDDEN.

Dogs under the age of 12 months ARE NOT permitted to use jump equipment higher than 400 mm, or longer than 800 mm.

Pursuant of the Health act "Dogs" ARE NOT permitted inside the Clubrooms. In the interest of safety and health, and in consideration of others, parents are required to supervise the behaviour of their children. The Clubrooms and Toilets MUST NOT be used as playing areas.

In the interests of public health the Clubrooms and the verandah area are NON-SMOKING areas.

Training Extreme Weather Policy Training will be cancelled if the forecast temperature for West Beach is predicted to be 37 degrees or above or an Extreme Storm warning is issued on [www.eldersweather.com.au](http://www.eldersweather.com.au) at 6pm the night before training (Wednesday nights and Sunday mornings).

Appropriate foot wear must be worn at ALL times when handling / double handling dogs on the Club grounds. Bare feet, thongs, slip on shoes, high heels, sandals or crocs and shoes with metal-spiked soles are not suitable foot wear and members wearing any of the above will be asked to leave the training area.
